

Driving from MI or Further East?

US HWY 10 cuts across Michigan east to west... if you want to avoid driving through Chicago or up and over the Upper Peninsula of Michigan, you may want to consider taking the Badger car ferry. It runs between Ludington MI & Manitowoc WI. It is NOT inexpensive, but it is a shipboard experience.




Late September Weather

September

Temperatures: Mild and pleasant, with average highs around 70°F and lows around 58°F early on, cooling as the month progresses.

Feel: Generally mild to cool, potentially windy, and perfect for light clothing like t-shirts.

Key: Marks the end of the warm season, but still feels comfortable, with colorful leaves emerging.

October

Temperatures: Significantly cooler, with highs dropping from the low 60s°F to the low 50s°F and lows from the mid-40s°F to the high 30s°F.

Feel: Moderately chilly and often windy, requiring warmer layers like jackets.



Close by Things to See & Do

- Manitowoc built submarines and boats in WWII. The USS Cobia is open for tours – and sleep-overs – at The Wisconsin Maritime Museum (Next door to the hotel).
- The last of the coal fired, steam engine car ferry ships on the Great Lakes in the SS Badger. Take a tour, or extend your visit with a ride east to Luddington MI for great shopping, food, or a ride in the dunes.



Some might like to sail...

Through my day-job, I have developed relationships with two organizations with larger sailing vessels. **If the weather cooperates and the vessels are still in the water** (early October is usually when they are placed *on the hard* for the winter), **we may well have the chance to get underway, under sail.**

The Schooner *Utopia* was built in 1946 in Sturgeon Bay and has been around the world a few times. In 2024, the current owners completed a renovation and have begun to offer sail-away opportunities. While the vessel was built in Sturgeon Bay, it is now moored near the hotel in Manitowoc. An outing on *Utopia* would likely have a fee and be a pleasure trip out and back.

Patriot Racing Project is a non-profit organization founded by veterans to restore classic sailboats, then sail and race them to help veterans re-connect with that feeling of teamwork and camaraderie they had when they served. Their newest project is a 50' yawl with a hull built in Manitowoc by a shipyard worker who built subs during WWII, and when the war ended was able to buy steel at pennies on the dollar, and that is what the “***Stjarna***” (*dshar-na*) is built from. Captain Jack (former Marine) tells me he will happily have the vessel pier-side in Manitowoc for our reunion and happily go sailing with willing and capable crew. An outing on *Stjarna* is for those who want to take the halyard and helm. There's a little space for ride-alongs, but you better be willing to move quickly when we tack! The cost is your time, and any donation you wish to make to the Patriot Racing Project – but none is required.
